INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM (IEP)

ENGLISH CONVERSATION AND CULTURE PROGRAM (ECC)

- ✓ Each block includes 15 hours of instruction per week for four weeks.

The English Conversation and Culture program is for part-time students who want to improve their language skills and have plenty of time for cultural experiences.



Integrated classes focus on developing not only speaking, listening, reading, and writing, but also cultural skills that will help students interact effectively on activities and trips to popular destinations throughout Southern California. This program does not meet the requirements of an F1 Visa, but it's available to students who have a B2 Visa.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

INTENSIVE ENGLISH SUMMER PROGRAM (IESP)



20 hours of instruction a week for six weeks

The Intensive English Summer Program is for students who want to develop skills for everyday communication. Our multi-level integrated skills approach is based around immersing students in the English language and American culture for more natural language acquisition –both in the classroom and outside of it.
